



Staff And Student Copyright Acknowledgement of Use of the Online Library Resources

Usage of subscription resources made available to me by the Online Library as a student or member of staff of the University of Wales is subject to the following conditions:

1. Ensure that all the requirements of the agreements, contracts and licences under which the resources are held by the University of Wales will be maintained. (Copies of the relevant agreements, contracts and licences may be seen by application to the Online Library of the University of Wales.)
2. To not remove or alter the Copyright Statement on any copies of the resources used by me.
3. Ensure the security and confidentiality of any copy of the resources released to me, and will not make any further copies from it or knowingly permit others to do so, unless permitted to do so under the relevant licence.
4. Create printouts of materials retrieved through the resources via on-line printing, off-line printing, facsimile or electronic mail. All reproduction and distribution of such printouts, and all downloading and electronic storage of materials retrieved through the resources will be for internal or personal use.
5. To not download all or parts of the resources in a systematic or regular manner so as to create a collection of materials comprising all or part of the resources as this is strictly prohibited whether or not such collection is in electronic or print form.
6. Only incorporate the resources, or part thereof, in any work, program or article produced by me, where this is permitted by the licence or by "Fair Dealing".
7. Only incorporate some part or version of the resources in any work produced by me with the express permission of the Licensor or unless this is permitted under Agreement.
8. To not reverse engineer or decompile the software products or attempt to do so unless this is explicitly permitted within the terms of the Agreement for the use of the resources.
9. Return or destroy all copies of the resources at the end of the course/year/period of study or when requested to do so.
