# Pwysigrwydd y 'brand'

## What's in a brand?

Mae grym brandio yn amlwg - meddylwch am frand pwerus byd-eang fel Coca Cola er enghraifft. Ond gall sefydliad fel prifysgol fod ar ei hennill lawn gymaint o ddefnyddio brand yn gyson. Mae brand yn llawer mwy na logo yn unig: mae'n gwneud llawer mwy nag ategu diwyg y deunydd marchnata. Gall brand esgor ar emosiwn, ymlyniad a chredoau, a gall sicrhau fod pawb o fewn y sefydliad hwnnw yn deall ei werthoedd ac yn gweithredu fel llysgennad i'w weledigaeth a'i uchelgais.

Nid rhywbeth sydd wedi'i 'ddyfeisio' yw brand Prifysgol Cymru. Mae brand pwerus yn rhywbeth sydd yn cael ei adeiladu ar wirioneddau sylfaenol yn hytrach na dyheadau yn unig. Mae brand Prifysgol Cymru wedi bod dan ystyriaeth dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf mewn ymgynghoriad â rhanddeiliaid allweddol a thrafodaethau â dwsinau o bobl ddylanwadol mewn meysydd academaidd, busnes a'r llywodraeth. Yna cynhaliwyd profion lleoli'r brand gyda chynfyfyrwyr a myfyrwyr cyfredol. Llwyddodd y brand a ddewiswyd - sy'n defnyddio elfennau gorau hunaniaeth sefydledig y Brifysgol mewn ffordd ffres - i sgorio'n uchel ac ystyriwyd ei fod yn ddeniadol, yn berthnasol ac yn gredadwy.

### Felly beth mae brand y Brifysgol yn ei gynrychioli?

- **gwarchod safonau academaidd**
- **ystyried etifeddiaeth fel adnodd gwerthfawr, heb fod yn llyffethair**
- **annog rhannu syniadau a diwylliant**
- **gosod addysg wrth galon cymunedau ac economïau cynaliadwy**
- **mynd â'r gorau o Gymru i'r byd a denu'r gorau o'r byd i Gymru.**

Mae'r broses o ailystyried brand y Brifysgol wedi bod yn llawer mwy na diweddarau'r diwyg yn unig. Mae wedi bod yn gyfle gwerthfawr i fireinio a hybu amcanion y sefydliad, a chryfhau a chynyddu'r modd y caiff y rhain eu diwallu. Yn bennaf oll, mae wedi gosod her i bob aelod o staff y Brifysgol! Mae'r holl broses o feddwl am ein cynlluniau, a'r ffordd orau i'w cyflawni, wedi gwneud i bob un ohonom ni edrych o'r newydd ar yr hyn sydd bellach yn gymuned wirioneddol fyd-eang ac aildarganfod – ac efallai aiddiffinio – ein lle ni ein hunain yn y gymuned honno.

Oni bai eich bod chi wedi graddio eleni, byddwch chi'n sylwi fod eich cylchgrawn hefyd wedi newid, gyda diwyg ac enw newydd. Bydd siaradwyr Cymraeg wrth gwrs eisoes wedi gwerthfawrogi ystyr dwbl y teitl newydd. Rwy'n gobeithio, gyda'n gilydd y gallwn ninnau anelu at fod yn gampus!

The power of branding is clear for all to see when it comes to products – think of a powerful global brand such as Coca Cola, for example. But an organisation like a university can benefit just as much from the consistent use of a brand. A brand is more than just a logo; it does much more than underpin what marketing material looks like. A brand can trigger important emotions, loyalties and beliefs, and can ensure that everyone in an organisation understands its values and can be an ambassador for a shared vision and ambition.

The University of Wales brand has not just been 'invented'. A powerful brand is built on fundamental realities and not wishful thinking. The University of Wales brand has been considered afresh during the last year in consultation with key stakeholders and discussions with dozens of influential people in academia, business and government. Brand positionings were then tested with alumni and current students. The chosen branding – using the best elements of the University's established identity in a refreshed way – scored highly and was seen to be appealing, relevant and credible.

### So what does the University of Wales brand stand for?

- **championing academic standards**
- **valuing heritage without being restricted by it**
- **encouraging the exchange of ideas and culture**
- **putting education at the heart of sustainable communities and economies**
- **taking the best of Wales to the world and bringing the best of the world to Wales.**



Reconsidering the University's brand has proved to be far more than simply updating its "look" to the outside world. It has provided a valuable opportunity to refine and promote the aims of the organisation, and to strengthen and increase the means of fulfilling these.

Above all, it has set a challenge for each member of the University's staff! The whole process of thinking about our plans, and how best to achieve them has made us all take a new look at what is now a truly global community, and to rediscover – and maybe redefine – our own place in that community.

Unless you have graduated this year, you will have noticed that your magazine has also changed, with a new look and a new name. Those of you who are Welsh speakers will already have appreciated the double meaning contained in the new title. Not only does **campus** refer to your place of study – and, indeed, the University's new Global Campus (see the next page) – but in Welsh the word has the meaning 'excellent'. I hope that, together, we shall be able to live up to that description!

– Cyflwyno ein Prosiect Campws Byd-Eang

## Not Just a Big Shiny Website

– Introducing our Global Campus Project



Er mai'r wefan newydd fydd cynnyrch mwyaf amlwg Campws Byd-Eang newydd y Brifysgol, mae'r prosiect wedi'i gynllunio i fod yn fenter lawer ehangach. Ei nod yw darparu ystod gynhwysfawr o wasanaethu ar-lein, wedi'u gyrru gan system rheoli cynnwys menter. Y prif amcan yw galluogi cydweithio effeithiol – yn fewnol ac allanol – rhwng staff y Brifysgol, adrannau, sefydliadau a myfyrwyr, presennol a gorfennol. Bydd myfyrwyr, cyn-fyfyrwyr, ymchwilwyr a staff y sefydliadau yn gallu defnyddio nodweddion rhwydweithio cymdeithasol, ysgrifennu blogiau, creu grwpiau trafod, rhannu ffeiliau ac uwchlytho fideos. Ein gobaith yw creu cymuned gref, fyd-eang, gwbl ryngweithiol o staff, myfyrwyr a chyn-fyfyrwyr – Prifysgol yng ngwir ystyr y gair.

Wrth galon y Campws fydd ei system Rheoli Cynnwys (CMS) – amgylchedd awduro gwe hawdd ei ddefnyddio, sy'n caniatáu i bawb gyfrannu'n hawdd. Y teclyn awduro hwn yw'r allwedd i lwyddiant y CMS. Gall staff Cyfathrebu ddiweddarau newyddion a datganiadau i'r wasg, a gall Swyddog Dilysu ddiweddarau manylion y sefydliadau partner a'r cyrsiau rydyn ni'n eu dilysu iddyn nhw. A bydd staff academaidd, myfyrwyr a chyn-fyfyrwyr yn canfod ffyrdd newydd o gyfathrebu, o wella'u hastudio – a hyd yn oed ymlacio! Bydd CMS y Campws Byd-Eang yn darparu llw o nodweddion defnyddiol eraill, gan gynnwys nodweddion cydweithio, cyfathrebu, amserlennu, e-fasnach ac adnodd 'sgwrsio' â desg gymorth.

Byddwch yn barod ar gyfer lansio'r Campws Byd-Eang newydd ym mis Hydref.

Although a new website will be the most obvious product of the University's new Global Campus, the project is designed as a much wider-ranging venture. It aims to provide a comprehensive array of online services, driven by an enterprise content management system. The primary goal is to enable effective collaboration – internally and externally – between University staff, departments, institutions and students, past and present. Students, alumni, researchers and institution staff will be able to use social networking features, write blogs, form discussion groups, share files and upload videos. Our aspiration is to create a strong, world-wide, fully interactive community of staff, students and alumni – a University in the truest sense of the word.

At the heart of the Campus will be its content management system (CMS) – an easy-to-use web-based authoring environment, allowing everyone to contribute with ease. It is this authoring tool which is the key to the success of the CMS. While Communications staff can maintain news and press releases, a Validation Officer can maintain the details of partner institutions and the courses we validate for them. And academics, students and alumni will find new means of communicating, enhancing study – and even relaxing! The Global Campus CMS will provide a whole host of other helpful features, including collaboration tools, communication, scheduling, e-commerce and a helpdesk 'chat' facility.

Look out for the launch of the new Global Campus in October.

# Ein Academi Fyd-Eang Our Global Academy

**Yn rhifyn y llynedd amlinellwyd cynlluniau uchelgeisiol y Brifysgol i sefydlu'r Academi Fyd-Eang.** Rydym ni'n falch iawn i allu cyhoeddi fod menter gyntaf yr Academi, Ysgoloriaethau Arloesi Tywysog Cymru, wedi'i lansio'n ffurfiol gan Dywysog Cymru ym mis Mai, wedi i'r Brifysgol sicrhau cyllid partneriaeth o raglen ERDF Swyddfa Cyllid Ewropeaidd Cymru. Mae'r rhaglen £11.3M arloesol hon bellach yn datblygu prosiectau ymchwil a datblygu cydweithredol manwl gyda chwmnïau ar draws Cymru, ac mae ar fin dechrau recriwtio myfyrwyr gorau'r byd ar gyfer yr ysgoloriaethau PhD. Rhwng 2009 a 2012 byddwn ni'n cynnig 100 Ysgoloriaeth Arloesi Tywysog Cymru i fyfyrwyr PhD wedi'u lleoli o fewn diwydiant.

Bydd Ysgoloriaethau Arloesi Tywysog Cymru yn darparu cyflog flynyddol o £20,000 ac un taliad grant ymchwil o £5,000; a chan nad yw'n codi ffioedd dysgu mae hon yn un o'r rhaglenni PhD sy'n talu orau drwy'r byd. Yn 2009 rydym ni'n dechrau drwy gynnig 20 o Ysgoloriaethau Arloesi Tywysog Cymru, ac rydym ni'n chwilio am fynegiant o ddiddordeb gan fyfyrwyr yn y prif feysydd canlynol:

- **Economi Ddigidol:** Diwydiannau creadigol, TGCh, cyfathrebu symudol a diwifr diogel
- **Economi Carbon Isel:** technolegau adeiladu cynaliadwy, mentrau trydan adnewyddadwy, cerbydau carbon isel
- **Iechyd a Biowyddorau:** heneiddio a lles, niwrowyddorau, peirianeg feddygol, e-iechyd a delweddu
- **Peirianeg a Chynhyrchu Datblygedig:** deunyddiau datblygedig gan gynnwys micro a nanotechnoleg, systemau ymreolaethol

Mae ail brif raglen yr Academi Fyd-Eang, sef Arloeswyr Ymweld Tywysog Cymru, sydd â'r nod o ddenu 100 o'r prif ddiwydianwyr ac ysgolheigion i Gymru fel Athrawon Ymweld, yn dal i gael ei datblygu. Fodd bynnag, rydym ni'n falch o fod wedi croesawu ein Harloeswr Ymweld cyntaf, yr Athro Andrew Barron o Brifysgol Rice, Texas, sydd wedi bod yn helpu'r Brifysgol i beilotu'r rhaglen newydd. Bydd yr Arloeswyr Ymweld yn treulio rhwng 3 a 6 mis yn gweithio gyda chwmnïau, prifysgolion a'r llywodraeth i gynyddu diwylliant arloesi agored ar draws Cymru. Ein gobaith yw lansio'r rhaglen hon yn llawn ym mis Ionawr 2010 ac unwaith eto rydym ni'n edrych am unrhyw fynegiant o ddiddordeb oddi wrth academyddion a diwydianwyr cymwys: cysyllter â [arloeswyr.ymweld@cymru.ac.uk](mailto:arloeswyr.ymweld@cymru.ac.uk). **In last year's edition we outlined the University's ambitious plans to establish the Global Academy.** We are delighted to announce that the first of the Academy's initiatives, the Prince of Wales Innovation Scholarships, was formally launched by the Prince of Wales in May, after the University secured partnership funding from Welsh European Funding Office ERDF programme. This groundbreaking £11.3M programme is now developing detailed collaborative R&D projects with companies across Wales, and is about to start recruiting the world's top students for the PhD scholarships. Between 2009 and 2012 we will offer 100 prestigious Prince of Wales Innovation Scholarships for industrial based PhD students.

The Prince of Wales Innovation Scholarships will provide an annual stipend of £20,000 and a one-off £5,000 research grant; with no tuition fees charged this makes the programme one of best-rewarded PhD programmes in the world. In 2009 we are beginning by offering 20 Prince of Wales Scholarships, and are actively looking for expressions of interest from students in the four following main fields:

- **Digital Economy:** Creative industries, ICT, secure mobile and wireless communications
- **Low Carbon Economy:** sustainable building technologies, renewable electricity innovations, low carbon vehicles
- **Health and Biosciences:** ageing and well being, neurosciences, medical engineering, e-health and imaging
- **Advanced Engineering and Manufacturing:** advanced materials including micro and nanotechnology, autonomous systems

The second major programme within the Global Academy, Prince of Wales Visiting Innovators, whose aim is to bring 100 of world's top industrialists and academics to Wales as Visiting Professors, is still in development. However, we are delighted to have hosted our first Prince of Wales Visiting Innovator, Professor Andrew Barron from Rice University, Texas, who has been helping the University pilot the new programme. Visiting Innovators will spend between 3 to 6 months, working with companies, universities and government to increase the open innovation culture across Wales. We hope to launch this programme fully in January 2010 and are again looking for expressions of interest from suitably qualified academics and industrialists to [visiting.innovators@wales.ac.uk](mailto:visiting.innovators@wales.ac.uk). Mae'n dalent llenyddol rhyfeddol."

Ers iddo ennill y wobwr, mae Nam wedi dychwelyd i Gymru dair gwaith yn ei rôl fel llysgennad Gwobr Dylan Thomas. Ymddangosodd yng Ngŵyl y Gelli ac yng Nghanolfan Dylan Thomas i siarad am ei waith. Yn bwysicach fyth, mae wedi cyfrannu at ddigwyddiadau i blant ysgol a myfyrwyr, fel rhan o'r rhaglen addysg a drefnwyd ar y cyd rhwng y Wobr a'r Brifysgol - rhywbeth y bu'r holl awduron ar y rhestr fer yn ei wneud yn ystod eu hwythnos yng Nghymru ym mis Tachwedd. In our last edition we announced the University's sponsorship of one of the world's highest paying literary awards, The Dylan Thomas Prize. The Prize is designed to encourage creative talent in writers under the age of 30. It is a global award, open to any work, from any genre, which has been published in the English language.

The University's sponsorship of the Dylan Thomas Prize is intended to provide the winner with the freedom to develop his or her skill without the financial pressures faced by so many of today's budding literary talents. This unique benefit makes the Dylan Thomas Prize one of today's most important literary prizes.

After what Peter Florence, Chair of the international judging panel, described as a very difficult choice from an extremely competitive shortlist of six immensely talented finalists, the 2008 Dylan Thomas Prize was awarded to Nam Le, for his book of short stories, *The Boat*. The award was made at an exclusive ceremony in Dylan Thomas's home town, Swansea, in November 2008.

In announcing the winner, Peter Florence said: "In Nam Le, I am

confident we have found a winner worthy of Dylan Thomas, his outstanding work demonstrated a rare brilliance that is breathtaking both in the scope of its subject matter and the quality of its writing... He is a phenomenal literary talent."

Since winning the prize Nam has returned to Wales three times in his role as an ambassador for the Dylan Thomas Prize. He has appeared at the Hay Festival and the Dylan Thomas Centre to talk about his work. Even more importantly, he has contributed to events for schoolchildren and students, as part of the education programme jointly arranged by the Prize and the University – something which all the shortlisted writers took part in during their week in Wales in November. As the University's Vice-Chancellor, Professor Marc Clement, commented, "Through this initiative, the Prize's global reach and aspirations, its focus on youth and its emphasis on nurturing excellence start right from grass roots level, capturing the imagination of young children who could be the future stars of literature."

We look forward to following Nam Le's career, and to welcoming him back to Wales soon!

**Canolfan ymchwil benodol yw Canolfan Uwchegyddiau Cymreig a Cheltaidd Prifysgol Cymru**, sydd wedi'i lleoli nesaf at Lyfrgell Genedlaethol Cymru, ac mae ei staff yn cynnal prosiectau ymchwil amlddisgyblaethol pwysig. Mae ei gwaith – sy'n cynnwys astudiaethau o bwys rhyngwladol o ddiwylliant a hunaniaeth Geltaidd yn ogystal â'r geiriadur hanesyddol cyntaf o'r Iaith Gymraeg, a enwyd gan Universities UK fel un o'r "100 o ddarganfyddiadau, datblygiadau a dyfeisiadau pwysicaf i'w gwneud mewn prifysgolion yn y DU yn ystod y 50 mlynedd diwethaf sydd wedi cael effaith ar y byd" – wedi ennill clod byd-eang a thros y ddwy flynedd diwethaf mae wedi denu dau o'r grantiau mwyaf erioed gan Gyngor Ymchwil y Celfyddydau a'r Dyniaethau i sefydliad addysg uwch yng Nghymru.

**Yn Ymarfer Asesu Ymchwil 2008** cyflawnodd y Ganolfan gamp aruthrol wrth i 35 y cant o'i gwaith gael ei raddio fel gwaith sy'n "arwain y byd" a 45 y cant yn "rhagorol yn rhyngwladol". **The University of Wales Centre for Advanced Welsh and Celtic Studies**, which is adjacent to the National Library of Wales, is a dedicated research centre whose staff are engaged on major multidisciplinary research projects. Its work – which includes internationally-important studies of Celtic culture and identity as well as the first complete historical Dictionary of the Welsh Language, named by Universities UK as one of '100 major discoveries, developments and inventions made in UK universities during the last 50 years that have impacted on the world' – has won universal acclaim and it has, in the past two years, attracted two of the largest grants ever made by the Arts and Humanities Research Council to a higher education institution in Wales.

**In the 2008 Research Assessment Exercise** the Centre received the accolade of having 35 per cent of its work rated as "world-leading" and 45 per cent as "internationally excellent". This very gratifying result, a matter of no little pride to all of us right across the University, both recognised the exceptional research carried out by its staff and confirmed its status as an international centre of excellence for Welsh and Celtic Studies. Director Dafydd Johnston attributed much of the credit for this to his predecessor Professor Geraint Jenkins, whose tireless work led to a stream of successes for the Centre. Professor Johnston and his team are fully engaged in the task of developing the Centre's work still further. The subjects of their current research projects range from Ancient Britain and the Atlantic Zone, via the works of the fifteenth century poet, Guto'r Glyn, to Wales and the French Revolution.

**The Centre also holds regular research-related events**, the latest being an international conference to mark the tercentenary of the death of the great Celtic scholar Edward Lhuyd.
